



A37 - Policy on Research Using Horses, Program or Participants

All research between Turning Point and another organizations must comply with federally recognized standards and requirements for the conduct of research efficacy studies involving human and/or animal subjects.

Turning Point staff participating in research collaborations will complete any required training and certification for specific projects.

All research collaborations will follow all confidentiality policies set forth by Turning Point. All research involving horses and participants must have a Turning Point staff member present.

All participants and/or guardians of participants will be notified of any research project. They will be given the opportunity to opt out of the research or have findings involving their part in it held anonymous.

Turning Point will be listed as co-author and must approve any material shared by the second party. All background material on Turning Point submitted as part of research or grant proposals must be reviewed and approved by Turning Point.
